## President's Message

This month's column is an outgrowth of following my own advice...not a common occurrence. Yesterday, Woody Duncan told me I had a 24 hour deadline! So this morning, I woke up early and laid in bed, thinking about watercolor. I don't know that I have the most cohesive thoughts going this morning (only 1 cup of coffee consumed so far) but thought I'd share a few with you. A lot of my thinking about watercolor comes from reading, watching and listening to others. So here are a few thoughts that evolved from each.



A quote from Georgia O'Keefe (Artist): "To create one's world in any of the arts takes courage."

This year, I've seen so many instances of member's courage. Certainly, the Fall Show displays the extent of everyone's courage, not only to paint but to show their work to others. A more recent personal example occurred yesterday in my paint group. Sally Boyd was re-visiting a painting she had worked on a while back. Ideas were shared on what might be done. I suggested some value change in the corners of the sky and that she might "creep up on it". Later in the morning, I checked to see what was going on and was amazed. Sally had boldly and expressively added bunches of color and value change...what courage!...adding enormously to the mood and drama of the painting.

A quote from John Maeda (Author, The Laws of Simplicity): "The fundamental question is, where's the balance between simplicity and complexity?"

What a delicate balance we have to keep in painting our subject matter. What to put in, what to leave out. John Maeda suggests that we use "thoughtful reduction" to achieve simplicity. By doing so in art, we leave more room for the viewer to complete our painting. Ideally, the end result is the desired emotive communication between artist and viewer. Problematically, as I leave out details, the end result often looks to me like "muddy soup."

As we think and work in watercolor, we'll look for balance, complexity, simplicity, courage. But, as this is the last Brushstrokes before the New Year, there is one most important thought to share:

**ENJOY ....AND HAPPY HOLIDAYS EVERYONE!**

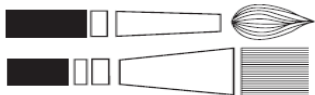
