

1. Paintings to bring in, 3 or 4, water medium
2. Watercolor mediums, paints, crayons (love those woodies), pencils, liquid acrylics, gouache, inks ( your choice, a few, many, all)
3. Paper or appropriate supports, have more than you might use
4. Acrylic gel medium, matte finish
5. Palette knives, putty knife, shapers one or all, used to move paint
6. Masking tape, (no blue painters taped)
7. Scissors or mat knife
8. Tracing paper
9. Drawing utensils, could be whatever you want to use, pencils, charcoal, markers
10. Transfer paper
11. Magazines, remember the answer to your painting dilemma is never more than an arm length away.
12. Some old paintings that you might choose to use as collage, you have to be willing to cut them up
13. Elmer's glue, or some white glue
14. Water containers, paper towels all the necessary items like that
15. Mark makers, forks, sticks, dental tools, toothbrush, wire brush, old oil painting brushes or anything you might want to make marks
16. I will be demonstrating how one might incorporate lettering into your work, so I have many stamps, ink blocks, stencils which I will bring to share. If you have your own you certainly can bring them
17. I will also bring brayers and razors to use.
18. And something to tote all these items!!!!
19. Also, get a good nights sleep, eat a good breakfast because we will be working hard! Bring your best energy to class.
